Qualifications Basic qualifications (required at time of application)

Candidates must have an MD, PhD, or MD/PhD or equivalent in a relevant field of Pediatrics. Candidates with an MD must be eligible for a California medical license or

equivalent certification/permit as determined by the Medical Board of California. Candidates with an MD must be board certified or board eligible in Pediatrics or Pediatric subspecialties. For candidates involved in clinical care must have an MD, MD/PhD, or equivalent.

Preferred qualifications

Candidates with substantial, existing and continuing funding are preferred. Candidates that show a demonstrated commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion are preferred.
